Christian Schaack has been a Member of the Board of Directors and Chairman of the Board Risk Committee of Banque Internationale à Luxembourg, S.A. (BIL) since November 2016.

Christian Schaack is a Non-Executive Independent Director of several companies and medium-sized banks. He occasionally teaches a course in mathematics for finance at the SHU Jack Welch College of Business in Luxembourg, as Adjunct Professor of Finance.

Christian Schaack started his career as an academic, teaching Managerial Economics in Harvard Business School's MBA programme from 1986 to 1989. He then joined McKinsey&Co, before joining Banque Générale du Luxembourg (BGL, today BGL BNP Paribas) in 1991. He occupied various senior management positions, including Member of the Executive Committee of BGL in Luxembourg (now BGL BNP Paribas) and of Fortis Bank in Brussels (now BNP Paribas Fortis).

Christian Schaack is a Luxembourgish national and holds a Ph.D. in Operations Research from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in Cambridge, Mass., an S.M. in Management from MIT's Sloan School, as well as an engineering degree from the Ecole Polytechnique, Paris.
